

Lengishu is an exclusive use family home found at the centre of Borana Conservancy, Kenya's newest and most successful rhino sanctuary.

The house boasts uninterrupted views of the Lengishu hills, the Lewa-Borana landscape and deep into the Northern Frontier.

With an arid landscape to the North and ancient indigenous forests surrounding Mount Kenya in the South, Borana Conservancy is a convergence of habitats where a variety of wildlife thrive.



Borana's grassy hills, deep valleys and open plains are home to The Big Five, a refuge for Kenya's endangered species. Lengishu is nestled quietly into a ridge line and blends seamlessly into its surroundings, due to its sustainably sourced design. Stone was excavated from the site itself, earth from the hillside clads the walls and all the timberwork was sourced from within Kenya.

The main house forms the focal point of Lengishu with vaulted ceilings and large inviting fireplaces.

Four cottages are arranged along the hillside, each elegantly furnished with unique style and character. Accommodating up to twelve guests, this private home is perfect for large family gatherings and groups of friends.
